




The living room: upholstered benches with luggage space inside, and folding table. The floor is covered with durable matting. (Large photo left)



The "wardrobe" is a real wardrobe, high and broad enough for coats, suits and dresses to hang full length.





The interior is insulated and trimmed with heat resisting plywood (Limba). The upholstery is of "Moltopren", a moth and termite-proof material which is wellnigh everlasting. Curtains are fitted to all the windows and also separate the driving compartment from the interior.



The living-cum-workroom is roomy enough for four people and has a folding table and two wide, padded benches. While on the move a garden table and chairs for the veranda can be fitted snugly between the benches.
